1. Read each night and log your reading on a log sheet.
2. In Math, we have been learning how to describe two-dimensional shapes by their attributes, such as the number of sides, name, number of vertices (corners), parallel sides, and types of angles. In our Working with Words lessons, we have been learning about compound words (two words joined together) and contractions (two words joined together, some letters are dropped and an apostrophe is placed where the letters are dropped).
